On behalf of the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC), I would like to invite you to be part of the first batch of Filipino education leaders who will take an executive course on **“Transforming Education Leaders through Effective Policy Reforms”** to be delivered by the **Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy of the National University of Singapore**.

With the continuing reforms in the country’s education system, foremost of which is the implementation of the K to 12 program, it is important that the education leaders, particularly in private education, are able to respond to the changing landscape by using the essential tools in policy analysis and evidence-based policy development, among others.

The Executive Education of the LKY School of Public Policy is part of the National University of Singapore, a world-class institution consistently ranked among the best in Asia and in the world. It has a dedicated faculty and senior practitioners who bring relevant real-life policy experience.

The course will run for five days and is scheduled on **July 2-6, 2018 at the Bukit Timah Campus of the National University of Singapore**. There is a course fee of **Php115,000.00**, which includes course materials in soft copy, certificate, and lunch for five days. On-campus accommodation is optional at SGD377 per person per week (or an additional Php15,000). The fee does not include airfare, incidentals, and other daily expenses in Singapore.
