

- O No evidence of compliance with standard nor plan of action is presented

# **2018 CAI Overall Final Ratings**

#### **Full Compliance with Innovations**

Final rating of 4 in all Core Areas and 3 or higher in Support Areas

#### **Full Compliance**

Final rating of 3 in all Core Areas and 2 or higher in Support Areas

#### **Substantial Compliance**

Final rating of 2 with 3 or higher in at least 2 Core Areas and 2 or higher in Support Areas

#### **Partial Compliance**

Final rating of 2 in all Core Areas and 2 or higher in Support Areas

#### **Limited Compliance**

Final rating of 1 with 2 or higher in at least 2 Core Areas and 1 or higher in Support Areas

#### **Failed**

Final rating of 1 or 0

# **ESC Implementing Guidelines** for Continued Participation

### Certification/Recertification Revisits (SY 2022-2023)

- For continued participation in the ESC Program
   Certification/Recertification Revisits shall be conducted to applicant schools/participating schools, respectively, which attained an Overall Certification Rating of below 3, specifically:
  - Limited Compliance
  - Partial Compliance
  - Substantial Compliance

# **ESC Implementing Guidelines** for Continued Participation

### Certification/Recertification Revisits (SY 2022-2023)

- Area Certification/Recertification Revisits shall be on the:
  - 1st/immediate year after the last visit/activity for those with Limited Compliance on Core and Support Areas rated 1
  - 2nd year after the last visit/activity for those with Partial Compliance on ALL Core Areas Rated Below 3
  - 3rd year after the last visit/activity for those with Substantial Compliance on Core Areas Rated Below 3

#### **Retained Certification/Recertification Status**

- Certification/Recertification Revisit No marked improvement is manifested.
- Second Area Certification Revisit activity
- Full and Complete Certification/Recertification Revisit conducted on the immediate year following, consequently not raising the level of the Overall Certification status of the school.

<sup>\*</sup>Should the school fail to improve its Certification/Recertification status after these revisits, the school reverts to the lower status corresponding to its last revisit rating.

# Implications of a Retained Certification Status on School Eligibility and ESC Grantees

 The school is granted Conditional Participation where no Grade 7 slots and additional slots shall be granted to the school pending an improved Overall/Final Rating after the Full and Complete Revisit.

#### **Failed Certification/Recertification Status**

- Happens when the school receives an Overall/Final Rating of 1 or 0 after:
  - An Area Certification/Recertification Revisit
  - Full and Complete Certification/Recertification Revisit immediate school year following the failed Area Revisit

# Implications of a Failed Certification/Recertification on School Eligibility and ESC Grantees

 Termination of the school from the ESC Program shall be implemented in the immediate school year following the revisit starting with no Grade 7 slots. Grade 8-10 ESC grantees shall be allowed to finish JHS.

### Failure of Certification/Recertification Activity (FoA)

Happens when the Certification/Recertification Activity/Revisit
 Activity did not proceed as scheduled without prior notice from the
 school or approval from PEAC Executive Director. The school
 submits a letter of information on the failure of activity and upon
 deliberation on the case, a Certification/Recertification Revisit
 Activity may be scheduled the following school year. A second FoA
 means a Failed Certification/Recertification status for the school.

#### **PEAC Guidelines for Continued Participation**

- Certified Status This happens when the school attains an Overall Certification Rating of 3; an Overall Certification Rating of 3 with a 4 in at least 2 Core Areas; an Overall Certification Rating of 4.
- However, eligibility to participate is extended even for those with Substantial to Limited Compliance.

#### **Incentives of a Certified Status**

 Recognition for having attained Certified Status shall be presented to the school during the Annual GASTPE Orientation Assembly.

### **Training of Certifiers**

- August 20 for Senior certifiers
- August 27 for Junior certifiers
- September 3 for New certifiers

- 5 offerings this SY 22-23: August 26, 29, and 31; September 2 and 5
- Dates are open to all regions

# Dates to Remember SY 2022-2023 Certification

Activity	Submission of Part I and II Documents	Submission of Part III Documents or ECEs
eRecertification schools	August 1, 2022 – September 23, 2022	One month before scheduled activity
Revisit schools	November 7,2022 – January 6, 2023	One month before scheduled activity
Certification schools (applicants)	August 1, 2022 – October 28, 2022	One month before scheduled activity

- ✓ FAAP-accredited schools are exempted from Certification/Recertification.
- ✓ Reminder on Part I documents

#### **Hybrid Protocols for Certification Activities SY 22-23**

- Recertifications and Revisits will remain online.
- Certification of applicant schools will be in-person.
- Same documents will be submitted to PEAC regardless the protocol that will be observed; applicant schools will be expected to exhibit documents (submitted or otherwise) during the visit.

#### Orientation for Non-ESC and Non-Accredited Schools

- an activity to encourage non-ESC schools support Internal Quality Assurance or even apply for ESC
