


1 Reduction in the number of tracks

















2 Learners' Preferred Curriculum Exit and Career Interests







Distribution of Grade 11 Learners based on Preferred Career as of July 17, 2025 (N=824)






3 Matching of Faculty Qualifications with Preferred Electives








SYSTEM SUPPORT
