Greetings from the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC)!

As part of its mandate to co-implement the Department of Education's (DepEd) Government Assistance to Students and Teachers in Private Education (GASTPE) Program, the PEAC promotes and helps ensure quality in private schools through the PEAC Certification process.

Through PEAC Certification, private junior high schools undergo an external quality assurance process that enables them to assess their level of compliance with minimum K to 12 standards and DepEd requirements. The Certification results serve as a basis for determining a school's eligibility to participate in the Educational Service Contracting (ESC) Program. Consistent with current GASTPE guidelines, ESC grantees who complete junior high school are automatically eligible to receive the Senior High School Voucher Program subsidy.

In line with this commitment, we are pleased to invite two (2) of your school administrators to participate in the **PEAC Certification Seminar-Workshop for Non-ESC Junior High Schools**, to be held on **October 15-16, 2026, at Hotel Benilde Maison De La Salle**. Should your school wish to register more than two (2) participants, please send us a request as the additional registrants will be placed on a waitlist and may be accommodated subject to availability. This arrangement is intended to provide more schools with the opportunity to participate in this capacity-building activity.

**PEAC Certification Seminar Workshop for Non-ESC Junior High Schools
Hotel Benilde Maison De La Salle, Malate, Manila
October 15-16, 2026**

RATIONALE

Effective school improvement is high on the agenda of Philippine education policies. Integral to its mandate to uplift Philippine private education and in pursuit of its strategic direction of enabling and empowering schools, the Private Education Assistance Committee (PEAC) endeavors to strengthen and upgrade the continuous improvement efforts of schools. More specifically, PEAC has defined much-needed assistance interventions towards improvement of school quality such as professional development for administrators and teachers in order to meet the changing demands and challenges of the current educational system.

Optimizing the use of the 2024 Junior High School Certification Instrument (JHS CAI), PEAC is conducting a two-day training-workshop on internal quality assurance towards continuing school improvement for school administrators of Junior High Schools (JHS) who are not participating in the ESC program managed by PEAC. This training-workshop aims to first, orient school administrators on the importance and process of quality assurance as a vital mechanism for attaining school excellence. Second, the program introduces to the participants the 2024 JHS CAI, as a tool for quality assurance and a vantage point for school improvement planning.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of the training, the participants are expected to be able to do the following:

1. Explain the importance of conducting Internal Quality Assurance in the delivery of the JHS program
2. Map the delivery of the JHS (Grades 7-10) program with the Standards of Compliance in the JHS CAI
3. Unpack and discuss Standards of Compliance in the JHS CAI Core and Support Areas in terms of their Look-Fors and Evidences of Compliance
4. Conduct the process of self-assessment for Quality Assurance using the JHS CAI



5. Identify areas of school improvement planning and formulate corresponding sample SSIP
6. Assess the adequacy and alignment of their sample SSIP using the standards in the proposed JHS CAI and rubric evaluation form
