ISSUES AND CONCERNS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

- ❑ Lack of learning materials, equipment, tools, facilities, classrooms and workshops
- ❑ Lack of SHS teachers to teach specialized subjects
- ❑ concern on the request for additional and change of offering (it requires evaluation and validation of reports from DO) – needs time allowance
- ❑ Application for the JDVP-TVL, SDO prepared urgent reports; RO consolidated and submitted bulk of report of the recipient schools
- ❑ The need for intensive monitoring of the Senior HS implementing schools (both public and private) re: physical facilities, equipment, instructional teaching-learning materials; evaluation/supervision of their curricular offerings and their teaching staff

- ❑ The need for rescheduling the release of SHS-VP allotment to schools
- ❑ The consideration of funds needed to run/implement the Senior High School Program

What is the JDVP- TVL?

The JDVP-TVL is a program designed to optimize TVL learning by allowing SHS students enrolled in DepEd public schools to avail of vouchers and take their TVL specializations in eligible partner institutions from either private or non-DepEd public SHS, as well as TVIs, offering their desired specializations.



What is the JDVP- TVL?

A tuition fee assistance to Grade 12 students in DepEd public SHSs that have been ascertained to have major resource gaps for the completion of TVL specializations.

The tuition fee assistance is in the form of vouchers given to student beneficiaries to enable them to cross enroll for the completion of TVL specializations in eligible private SHSs, non Deped public SHS, or private TVI for the provision of TVL subjects.

The vouchers shall be settled by DepEd upon validation of billing statements submitted by JDVP-TVLP partners based on education and training services rendered to learner beneficiaries

WHO ARE THE BENEFICIARIES?

There are seventy-four thousand nine hundred twenty-two (74,922) Grade 12 students taking the TVL track in 958 participating DepEd public SHS schools who will be allowed to take their TVL specialization subjects in eligible private or Non-DepEd public SHSs and private TVIs for the remainder of SY 2017-2018.



How Much Subsidy Will be Provided Per Student?

DepEd Public SHS students may be subsidized for as much as P15,475.00 per learner-beneficiary for at most 4 specializations and a maximum of 160 hours. The payment to TVIs will depend on the duration of the TVL specialization. This shall cover tuition and miscellaneous expenses (consumables) for the remainder of SY 2017-2018.

The cost of one specialization is PhP 3,731.25

TVIs cannot charge public SHS students top-up fees.



SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL VOUCHER PROGRAM (SHS VP)

What is SHS VP?

SHS VP is a GASTPE program wherein financial assistance (in the form of tuition subsidies) is extended to qualified public and private Grade 10 completers enabling them to enroll for SHS – Grades 11 and 12 – in private and non-DepEd public schools.

Who can be SHS VP beneficiaries?

Eligibility

- Grade 10 completers in SY 2017-2018 may be Qualified Voucher Recipients (QVRs)
- QVRs are subdivided into (1) automatically qualified students and (2) voucher applicants

Qualified Voucher Recipients

Automatically qualified students

- Category A: All Grade 10 completers in Public JHSs
- Category B: All Grade 10 completers in SUCs and LUCs
- Category C: All Grade 10 completers in private schools who are ESC grantees

Voucher Applicants (VAs)*

- Category D: All Grade 10 completers in private schools who are not ESC grantees
- Category E: Students who took/will take the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test and the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT) in the current school year and passed and have been certified for admission to Grade 11 in SY 2018-2019, provided that they received their certification not later than May 31, 2018

*Successful applicants or Qualified Voucher Applicants (QVAs) are QVRs.

The following are not eligible:

- Learners who graduated High School in March 2015 or earlier
- Grade 10 completers who completed Grade 10 before or after SY 2017-2018
- Incoming Grade 12 students who were not part of the voucher program in Grade 11
- Non-Filipino students

I'm a private non-ESC Grade 10 completer, how do I apply?

- Voucher application for private non-ESC Grade 10 completers could have been done either manually or online. However, the application period has already ended.
- Deadline for application
 - 1st batch (manual): Jan. 31, 2018
 - 1st batch (online): Feb. 28, 2018
 - 2nd batch (strictly online): April 27, 2018

How will I know if my voucher application is successful?

- Results may be viewed through the Online Voucher Application Portal (OVAP) – <http://ovap.deped.gov.ph>
- Date of release of results:
 - 1st batch (manual/online): April 2, 2018
 - 2nd batch (strictly online): May 25, 2018
- Successful applicants will be able to download a QVA Certificate (formerly called a QVR Certificate) which signifies they are QVRs.
