

**In Celebration of National Teachers' Month
(September 5-October 5, 2020)**

***The Pedagogy of Online Learning*
November 7 and 14 | 8 AM-5 PM | via Zoom**

Program provider: Continuing Education for the Learning Professionals, Inc. (CELPI)

This is a two-day online training program designed to provide participants the empirical knowledge and skills in the practice of online and blended learning. Specifically, it focuses on teachers' pedagogical practices as they shift from the traditional classroom-based teaching to online. Participants are guided in designing learning activities both for synchronous and asynchronous online communication. Emphasis is made on the bridging of face-face instruction to online in the blended learning approach.

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

PEAC will choose 120 qualified private school teachers in GASTPE-participating schools who will get a chance to attend the webinar for free* and earn 15 CPD units.

*Succeeding training schedules will have a registration fee of Php2,800/participant.

Who are eligible to apply:

- The applicant must be a licensed teacher from a private school participating in the Education Service Contracting (ESC) or SHS Voucher Program (SHS VP).
- The participating school is in good standing in the programs.

How to apply:

- Write a letter of interest addressed to the PEAC Executive Director, Ms. Rhodora Angela F. Ferrer. The following information should be included in the letter:
 - Complete Name
 - Subject/s and Level/s Handled
 - Name and Address of the Participating School
 - ESC ID or DepEd ID of the Participating School
 - Short write-up on experiences implementing online learning this school year
 - Copy of valid PRC license
- Send the letter and other documents to programs@peac.org.ph and indicate "National Teachers' Month-The Pedagogy of Online Learning" in the subject line.

The PEAC National Secretariat will accept applications until October 5, 2020 or until all the 120 slots have been awarded.

How attendees will be selected:

- Applications will be screened based on the eligibility criteria and the completeness of the requirements.
- The 120 slots have been distributed evenly for applicants coming from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. After the screening, the selection will be done on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Only one attendee per school will be selected to accommodate as many private schools as possible.
- Successful applicants will be notified via email.
