The online courses are generally self-paced and asynchronous in the e-learning portal of MCE with only Courses 3 and 4 having a synchronous component via Zoom.

Educators are given three (3) months to complete the course and can earn e-certificates from the course provider and PEAC.

The courses are open to all educators in private and public schools and international schools in the Philippines and to educators in Philippine Schools Overseas (PSO).

The course fee is Php1,800/course/account.
